

## Unmissable Markets

### Fenshine Gift Market

- ✦ Bags ✦ shoes ✦ Perfumes ✦ scarves
- ✦ cosmetics ✦ souvenirs

#### Address

南京西路580号, 靠近成都路

#### Getting there

⇒ This market is in the city centre so a taxi is cheap from that area

- ⇒ Nearest metro stop is West Nanjing Road (Nanjing Xi Lu)
- ⇒ Exit 2

#### Handy Tips

- > Try 'Sam's Leather' on the second floor for good leather bags or ask in any concession for leather and they will produce some for you.
- > Expect to pay 100-200 yuan for non-leather bags and 600-1000 yuan for leather bags (depending on size and quality). Non-leather wallets can be 60-120 yuan.
- > Brand name cosmetics can be found on the third floor. There are good pearl shops on the third and fourth floors. Find your Louboutins on the third floor, front right corner, priced about 500 yuan for leather.
- > Don't be alarmed by the hidden rooms and don't forget to bargain!

## Unmissable Markets

### Science and Technology Museum 科技馆

- ✦ Pearl market ✦ bags ✦ clothes ✦ tailors

#### Address

世纪大道2000号, 近锦绣路

#### Getting there

- ⇒ Metro to Peoples Square
- ⇒ change to line 2 (green line)
- ⇒ five stops to Shanghai Science and Technology Museum.

A taxi is rather expensive: €10 compared to €0.40 for metro

#### Handy Tips

- > Wonderful pearl contact in the pearl market: the second shop on the right, on the wall near the main entrance: "Vicky Pearl". Tell them you're a friend of Stephanie and they're likely to give you a good price.
- > Daisy's Café is a good spot for lunch. Fresh soup, salads and toasted sandwiches served daily.
- > In search of leather handbags? Ask at concession B1-11, and they'll show you the good stuff!

### Old Town

#### Address

豫园, 安仁街137号, 近福佑路

#### Getting there

⇒ Metro stop: Yuyuan (Line 10)

#### Handy Tips

- Chinese-style old-fashioned curly-roofed area, bustling with souvenir shops, selling everything from tea, to jade, Chinese ornaments, *qipaos*, pearls, and Chinese name stamps.
- Get there before 5pm to enter the beautiful Yuyuan Gardens, for wonderful photo opportunities

#### Getting there

⇒ Metro stop: South Huangpi Rd (Line 1)

- Cosmopolitan eatery area, très atmospheric

### Taikang Road/ Tianzi Fang

泰康路/ 田子坊

#### Address

田子坊泰康路

#### Getting there

⇒ Line 10, metro stop: Dapujiao, exit 1

#### Handy Tips

- Artist taller district, fairy light-lined artistic alleys, lined with unique cafés and restaurants, trinket shops and galleries
- Prices quite high, but the atmosphere is most enjoyable and you can find some unique souvenirs
- Check out the Scent Museum
- Great for a coffee or a drink and a stroll on a nice day

## Hai - lights

### The Bund

外滩

#### Address

外滩, 近中山东一路

#### Getting there

- ⇒ Get metro to Peoples Square (Line 1, 2, 8)
- ⇒ Walk all the way down Nanjing East Road, the neon-illuminated street, and emerge on the Bund, the riverfront

#### Handy Tips

- Watch your bag whilst in crowded areas
- Stop in to Lost Heaven for a classy Chinese meal, with a view (延安东路17号, 近四川南路)
- Stop by The Roosevelt Rooftop Bar for a cocktail with a view (中山东一路27号9楼, 近北京东路)

### Century Park

世纪公园

#### Getting there

⇒ Line 2, six stops from Peoples' Square

#### Handy Tips

- Beautiful Central Park-style city park
